





Peter John Kreeft took his AB at Calvin College in 1959 and an MA at Fordham University in 1961. At the same university, he completed his PhD in Philosophy in 1965. He briefly did post-graduate studies at Yale University. Dr. Kreeft is a Professor of Philosophy at Boston College and The King’s College (Empire State Building) in New York City. He has also taught at Villanova University, St. Peter’s College, Haverford College, Rosemont College, La Salle College, St. Joseph’s College, St. Charles Seminary, Emmanuel College, Regis College, Newton College of the Sacred Heart, Boston State College, Berklee College of Music, Gordon College, St. John’s Seminary, and Our Lady of Grace Seminary. Shortly after he began teaching at Boston College, he was challenged to a debate on the existence of God between himself and Paul Breines, an atheist and history professor, which was attended by a majority of undergraduate students. Dr. Kreeft later used many of the arguments in this debate to create the *Handbook of Christian Apologetics* with then undergraduate student Ronald K. Tacelli, S.J. He has received several honors for achievements in philosophical reasoning. They include the following: Woodrow Wilson Fellowship, Yale-Sterling Fellowship, Newman Alumni Scholarship, Danforth Asian Religions Fellowship, and Weathersfield Homeland Foundation Fellowship. He is a popular writer of Christian philosophy, theology, and apologetics. Dr. Kreeft is in wide demand as a conferences speaker and has four short videos on prageru.com: *The Benefits of Belief*; *Where Do Good and Evil Come From*; *God and Suffering*; and *God vs. Atheism: Which is More Rational*. He is the author of more than 95 books, including *Letters to an Atheist* (2014), *How to Win the Culture War: A Christian Battle Plan for a Society in Crisis* (2002), *Refutation of Moral Relativism – Dialogues between a relativist and absolutist* (1999) the *Handbook of Christian Apologetics* (1994), *Yes or No?– Straight Answers to Tough Questions about Christianity* (1984) and *The Unaborted Socrates* (1983) - His books on C.S. Lewis include *C.S. Lewis: A Critical Essay* (2011), *Shadow-Lands of C.S. Lewis: The Man Behind the Movie* (1994), and *C.S. Lewis for the Third Millennium* (1994).
